

A safe and secure healthcare environment

The hospital must be a safe and secure healthcare environment for patients, visitors and staff.

Accordingly, the following rules of conduct apply within the hospital:

- The hospital is not a public place. The staff has the right to ask people who have no legitimate business at the hospital or who are perceived as disruptive, aggressive or threatening to leave.
- There will be zero tolerance of discrimination, threat and violence.
- Weapons of any kind are not allowed on the premises.
- Alcohol and drug use is not allowed.
- Smoking is allowed only in designated smoking areas on hospital grounds.
- Healthcare staff has the right to limit the number of accompanying persons or visitors to a patient.
- A permit is required to take photographs in the hospital.
- Animals are not allowed inside the hospital, except for assistance dogs and active working dogs such as police dogs.
- Sales of goods and services are not allowed.
- Collections of various types on behalf of external parties are not allowed.
- Distribution of information/messages from external stakeholders is not allowed
